

Panama Trans-Canal Cruise Celebrity Infinity Oct. 7-23, 2016

San Francisco to Fort Lauderdale

A once in a life-time vacation experience, you will cruise the Pacific Coast before a full-transit of the Panama Canal. You also may consider arriving San Francisco a day or two before the cruise to enjoy Fisherman's Wharf, China Town, the most crooked street in the world, cable car rides up and down the hills of this beautiful city and much more.

We will cruise past Los Arcos, the soaring rock archway at the extreme southern tip of Baja that guards Cabo's perfect harbor—an idyllic bay that once sheltered treasure ships from the Orient and pirate brigs bent on those treasures. Next we visit Puerto Vallarta, a quaint fishing village, which Hollywood discovered this back in the 1960s, and since then the luxury resorts and bougainvillea-covered villas have flourished in the delightful seaside climate.

From Puerto Quetzal you can visit Guatemala City, the capital, or travel back in time at Tikal, the most elaborate Mayan ruins ever found. The beautifully preserved town of La Antigua and the ancient sculptures at Ceibal are also nearby.

Tiny Puntarenas, on the Pacific Coast of Costa Rica, is situated between the volcanic beaches of the Golfo de Nicoya and some of the country's highest mountain peaks. Within a half-hour of the port, tropical jungles give up their secrets to the casual observer. Tree's flash with color as macaws, toucans, and parakeets take flight and bowler monkeys scream in the distance.

You will spend an unforgettable day cruising the Panama Canal, a fifty-one mile waterway through the rainforest that is one of the world's engineering masterpieces. There's more to Panama than the canal as you will learn in Colon. Panama's ethnic mix is reflected in its arts which honor its many Indian tribes and its rich Spanish legacy.

Our last port before reaching Fort Lauderdale, Florida will be Cartagena, Columbia, the oldest city in the New World and through which once poured the wealth of the Spanish Main—gold, silver and emeralds.
