GLASS BOTTOM BOAT TO LANDS END

CABO SAN LUCAS, MEXICO

You will be able to appreciate the calm waters of the Sea of Cortes and the swells of the Pacific Ocean on this boat tour to Land's End. During the tour, you will visit the sea lion colony, and be able to observe the friendly animals in their native habitat. You will also see the pelican colony on the Pelican Rock, jutting impressively out of the water. All the while, don't forget to look down to see the sea life through the glass bottom boat, swimming beneath your feet. And finally, get your camera ready, because you will be just next to the famous Arch! The Arch is a majestic rock formation and one of the most photographed areas in Cabo. Get the picture and experience of a lifetime on this fantastic Cabo glass bottom boat tour. Following the tour we will have time to explore the port town on our own before tendering back to the ship.

This adventure filled day highlights all the best sites in and around Puerto Vallarta. We'll begin by exploring the beautiful downtown area. Enjoy the tropics with a stroll along the lovely Malecon boardwalk. As you walk, you may notice signs of Puerto Vallarta's traditional nature. Community is everywhere and celebrations are encouraged. Embrace the Mexican attitude to get a deeper feel for its rich culture. You'll visit the most iconic church in the city, Our Lady of Guadalupe, which also serves as a symbol to the city itself. On to the "romantic zone," also known as the "Old Town." Here the small streets are filled with cafes, bars, restaurants, and shops. Perhaps a coffee is in order. Before continuing on, you'll see some of Puerto Vallarta's most famous sites, including Los Muertos Beach, covered in white sand and endless rays! Get a glimpse of Puerto Vallarta's own "Beverly Hills" as you drive past the gated Concha Chinas neighborhood, filled with extravagant mansions and tropical bungalows. A short drive takes you to Los Arcos, a popular destination for water activities, and a great place to take in scenic views of the Bay. Movie lovers will delight in our next stop, Mismaloya, the site where "Night of the Iguana" was filmed back in 1964. Ironically, the film was about a struggling tour guide and it is this very film that put Puerto Vallarta on the map as a popular tourist destination! It's time for lunch and our guide knows all the best local restaurants. We've saved the most fun for the last--a tequila learning facility. Don't worry, after learning, you will get to try some tequila too!

October 14

ENCHANTED CITY OF ANTIGUA - UNESCO HERITAGE SITE

PUERTO QUETZAL, GUATEMALA

Come join us on a cultural exploration of La Antigua, Guatemala, located about an hour and a half from the cruise ship terminal. Set out on this amazing scenic drive into the central highlands of Guatemala. If you're a photographer, you'll be in heaven! The area boasts well-preserved architecture and landscape. In fact, La Antigua has been designated a UNESCO World Heritage Site!

Once at La Antigua, we'll start off by visiting El Carmen market for some shopping (lots of Mayan people and Mayan handicrafts) and also walk through the various buildings that surround it, such as the Cathedral, The General Captains Palace, and Arms Museum. There's also a few gorgeous churches. Next, we'll break for lunch (the cost of lunch is not included). Your guide will make a couple of suggestions based on your lunch preferences. In the afternoon, we'll visit a jade factory, where beautiful jewelry is handmade.

At the conclusion of the tour, you'll be returned to the cruise ship terminal.

October 16

JUNGLE RIVER CRUISE PUNTARENAS, COSTA RICA

This tour includes:

- Entrance fee to the Tárcoles River Boat
- English-speaking naturalist guide

Famous for its large American Crocodiles, the Tárcoles River forms the Northern border of Carara Biological Reserve on the Central Pacific coast of Costa Rica. The Tárcoles is full of crocodiles, scarlet macaws, Jesus Christ lizards, and over 120 species of birds.

On this tour you will board a river boat and glide along this placid river with our naturalist guide. You will learn about all of the wildlife found in the rainforests as the guide describes the birds, animals, and habitat in great detail. After visiting the river mouth, we venture up a mature mangrove area, where we stop to learn about this remarkable ecosystem. Return upstream to the native botanic garden, where your guide explains more about the native plant species of this transitional habitat. This half-day, educational tour is designed for you to experience, photograph, and learn about the native wildlife.

October 19

THE CANAL AND COLONIAL PANAMA COLON, PANAMA

This tour includes:

Our journey begins with an exploration of the Panama Canal and Miraflores Visitor Center. Here, you'll enjoy the magnificence of this incomparable waterway, its history and much more. Be sure to watch the English language movie showing the history of the Canal and visit the four very comprehensive museum exhibits. Then it's time to make your way to the observation deck as the world's container vessels, tankers, cruise ships and the occasional recreational vessel pass beneath. Look down into the canal as the waters of Lake Gatun flow into the locks, raising Atlantic bound vessels and as they empty again, allowing ships to pass to the Pacific. Called "The Eighth Wonder of the World," the Panama Canal stands as a monument to mankind's ingenuity and the power of conviction.

Next we'll then venture into the Old City on foot and discover its many hidden treasures. Defined by its massive historic sea wall, Casco Viejo is a World Heritage Site that was built in the 1670s and was the first European settlement on the Pacific coast of the Americas. You'll feel as though you've stepped back in time as you admire the lovely colonial houses, narrow roads and impressive churches. You'll get a good feel for Panama's history as you walk through the main attractions of this quarter.

The conclusion of your excursion will bring you to the Causeway of Amador which connects the mainland of Panama City with its 3 islands; Naos, Pericos and Flamenco. Built in 1913, the causeway was originally part of a U.S. military tactic to defend any potential threats on the canal.

CITY DRIVE & LA POPA MONASTERY

Cartagena, Colombia

Cartagena is one of the most beautiful cities in Colombia. With a rich and fascinating history, there's plenty to explore. On this private Cartagena tour, enjoy a historical experience sure to leave you satisfied with fun facts and lots of sightseeing. Sites to visit include La Popa Monastery, San Felipe de Barajas Fortress, and the famed Walled City. Other highlights include a local shopping experience and drive through Bocagrande, a luxurious residential area.

We start the private Cartagena tour with a visit to La Popa Monastery. A winding road leads to the highest point in Cartagena, where Convento de la Popa sits atop a hill. This ornate monastery has a 22-karat gold foil altar and a gorgeous courtyard filled with flowers, a photographer's delight. Even better for pictures is the breathtaking view of the harbor and city. Continue to San Felipe de Barajas Fortress (named after Saint Philip IV), a striking sixteenth-century fortress atop a lush hill. This historic site is considered the most important work of Spanish Military engineering in South America.

Approximately ten minutes will be provided for photographs before continuing your private tour. Head to Las Bovedas (The Dungeons) for about 20 minutes of local handicraft shopping in a setting of wonderful architecture. Learn the historical importance of this landmark before continuing to your remaining destinations.

Visit Cartagena's Walled City, considered the "old town." This area is a gem of colonial architecture loaded with picturesque monasteries, churches, plazas, palaces, and mansions. Take a leisurely stroll, savoring the architectural details, shops, and local cuisine, then head to the Church of San Pedro Claver for a fascinating history lesson. Spanish-born monk Pedro Claver was nicknamed the "Slave of the slaves" for his lifetime work spent ministering slaves brought from Africa. We end this private tour with an enjoyable drive through Bocagrande, a luxurious residential area with elegant apartment complexes, hotels, and restaurants. Arrive at "Pierino Gallo," a delightful shopping location where you can purchase handicraft items and souvenirs. Afterward, a comfortable drive returns you to port. Book this private Cartagena tour today for a comprehensive historic experience of the city. Note: This tour includes walking five or more blocks.
